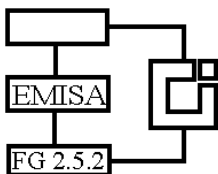


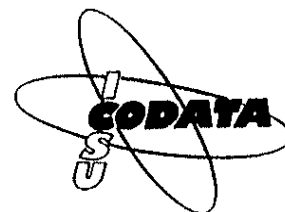

The manageability of complex information systems for multidisciplinary cooperation and its use in decision support depends on basic methods and techniques that cover application layers like

- access, compatibility and interoperability
- documentation of information models
- validation procedures and quality control
- financial and legal aspects (including copyright)
- enabling cooperation on information
- archiving
- education

This workshop brings together experts from fields that offer knowledge and techniques for the above mentioned aspects of Information Infrastructure and those who are interested in knowledge transfer of best practice into other disciplines.

CODATA (Committee on Data for Science and Technology of the International Council of Science) supports these cross-discipline aspects that are fundamental to open access and for qualified use of reliable data.

The workshop is organized adjunct to the International Symposium on "Sustainability in the Information Society" because it is expected that there is a fruitful exchange of interest as already experienced in previous cooperations between CODATA and the "Informatics in Environmental Protection" expert committee as well as EMISA - Special Interest Group on Development Methods For Information Systems - both are branches of the German Informatics Society.

This Workshop at ETH Zurich is planned to start on Friday, Oct. 12 11 h and to close on Saturday Oct. 13 16 h.

Besides presentation and discussion of papers the workshop is intended to collect recommendations for state-of-the-art best practice, to provide a research and development perspective for national and international action as well as to develop ideas on the role of CODATA in strategic support.

The workshop thus contributes to the fundamentals of Information Society.
